

Dear Parent:

This letter details the many ways you can access your lunch account information to avoid negative account balances:

The best solution for avoiding a negative balance is to estimate your family's weekly use of the food service and deposit money into your account on a regular basis (perhaps weekly) that provides for that level of use.

2009-2010 Prices: \$2.25 for middle and high school lunches, includes one carton of milk
 \$1.90 elementary lunches, includes one carton of milk
 \$1.25 second entrees
 \$.40 for reduced meals
 \$.35 for morning milk (**Parkview – through 3rd** grade). This is NOT included with the free program. If you do not want your child to have the morning milk, please talk to his/her teacher and they will remove their milk card.

Those qualifying for the free lunch program will receive hot lunch but do not receive second entrée's, ala-carte items, morning milk or extra milk at lunch unless the account has a positive balance.

There are many ways we provide account information.

1. You may check your account on-line, using your pin number. If you don't know your pin number, please call the secretary at the school your child(ren) attends, they will provide it for you.
2. Each cashier is notifying students verbally or will write down your balance if requested, when the child swipes their ID card or day planner.
3. You may call the food service department at 920-387-7960 ext. 160 and inquire regarding your account balance.

To make a deposit place a check or cash in an envelope and write the parents first and last name **along with your children's first and last name** on the outside of the envelope and drop it in the mail boxes provided at each school. If it is dropped off after 8:00 a.m, at MMS, or Parkview School it may not be entered until the following day.

Our goal is to provide nutritious, hot lunches for all students in a pleasant school environment. Families who keep a positive account balance will assure that their children will be served each day that they choose our lunch program.

When your account balance is negative, students are not permitted to purchase any items from the Ala Carte room at the high school. This has caused some students to respond negatively. We ask your cooperation in talking to your children and explaining this policy so that we can keep our lunchroom and ala cart room positive places for students.

Estimado padre:

Esta letra detalla las muchas maneras que usted puede tener acceso a su información de la cuenta del almuerzo para evitar equilibrios negativos de la cuenta:

La mejor solución para evitar un equilibrio negativo es estimar el uso semanal de su familia del servicio de alimento y depositar el dinero en su cuenta sobre una base regular (quizás semanalmente) que prevea ese nivel del uso.

2009-2010 precios: \$2.25 para los almuerzos de la High School media y secundaria, incluye un cartón de leche
\$1.90 almuerzos elementales, incluyen un cartón de leche
\$1.25 segundos entradas
\$.40 para las comidas reducidas
\$.35 para la leche de la mañana (**Parkview - con 3rd** grado). Si usted no quisiera que su niño comiera la leche de la mañana, hable por favor con su profesor y quitarán su tarjeta de la leche.

Ésos que califican para el programa libre del almuerzo recibirán el almuerzo caliente pero no reciben los segundos entrées, los artículos del ala-carte, la leche de la mañana o la leche adicional en el almuerzo a menos que la cuenta haga que un positivo balancee.

Hay muchas maneras que proporcionamos la información de la cuenta.

1. Usted puede comprobar su cuenta en línea, con su perno número. Si usted no sabe su perno número, llame por favor a secretaria en la escuela su niño (ren) atiende, ellos la proporcionará para usted.
2. Cada cajero está notificando a estudiantes verbalmente o escribirá abajo de su equilibrio si está solicitado, cuando el niño birla su tarjeta o día de la identificación planificador.
3. Usted puede llamar el departamento de servicio de alimento en 920-387-7960 exterior. 160 e investigan con respecto a su equilibrio de la cuenta.

Para hacer que un depósito pone un cheque o cobra adentro un sobre y escribe los padres primero y el nombre pasado **junto con su nombre de los niños primeros y pasado** en el exterior del sobre y cáigalo en las cajas del correo proporcionadas en cada escuela. Si se cae apagado después de que 8:00 mañana, en MMS, o la escuela de Parkview él no se pueda entrar hasta el día siguiente.

Nuestra meta es proporcionar los almuerzos nutritivos, calientes para todos los estudiantes en un ambiente de escuela agradable. Las familias que mantienen un equilibrio positivo de la cuenta asegurarán que servirán sus niños cada día que eligen nuestro programa del almuerzo.

Cuando su equilibrio de la cuenta es negativo, no permiten a los estudiantes para comprar ninguna artículos del cuarto del Carte del Ala en la High School secundaria. Esto ha hecho a algunos estudiantes responder negativamente. Pedimos su cooperación en hablar con sus niños y explicar esta política de modo que poder guardar nuestros lugares positivos del sitio del carro del lunchroom y del ala para los estudiantes.

Privacy Act Statement: This explains how we will use the information you give us.

The Richard B. Russell National School Lunch Act requires the information on this application. You do not have to give the information, but if you do not, we cannot approve your child for free or reduced price meals. You must include the social security number of the adult household member who signs the application. The social security number is not required when you apply on behalf of a foster child or you list a FoodShare Program, Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (W-2 cash benefits) Program or Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR) case number or other FDPIR identifier for your child or when you indicate that the adult household member signing the application does not have a social security number. We will use your information to determine if your child is eligible for free or reduced price meals, and for administration and enforcement of the lunch and breakfast programs. We MAY share your eligibility information with education, health, and nutrition programs to help them evaluate, fund, or determine benefits for their programs, auditors for program reviews, and law enforcement officials to help them look into violations of program rules.
