



SENIOR CHECKLIST

___ Apply EARLY to the college, university, or technical college you wish to attend. You are encouraged to apply on-line or with paper applications. Computer workstations are available in the guidance center for students to use.

___ Make sure that you meet all deposit deadlines for housing and admission to the different campuses. Keep all of the paperwork you receive from the campus and write down the name and telephone numbers of the personnel you speak with for future reference.

___ Admission letters sent to students generally state "final admission is contingent upon the student successfully completing courses in their senior year, and maintaining the high school class rank". If the high courses identified on the college application change during the school year, the student must call the university to inform them of the change. Please be aware that a student's admission is evaluated again when the college receives the final transcript with the senior grades.

___ Visit the college campuses you are interested in attending. The guidance office has a brochure entitled "PREPARING FOR YOUR COLLEGE/TECH VISIT..." for you to take with you on your visit with a variety of questions to ask. The guidance office staff would be happy to assist you in calling for your visit date. Parents are encouraged to attend.

___ College representatives visit Mayville High School throughout the year. Please watch for the visit schedule in the announcements and get a pass from Mrs. Weyer (guidance secretary) before school starts the morning of the visit.

___ N.C.A.A. Clearinghouse application needs to be filled out if you are an athlete interested in participating in sports at a Division I or Division II college. Applications are available in the guidance center.

___ Check the Scholarship Update on a monthly basis to see if you qualify for any scholarships. Mayville's Local Scholarship listing will be available in January, 2004.

___ Class rank and grade point average information is available in the guidance office. Be sure that you meet the admission requirements of the university you wish to attend.

___ ACT/SAT applications are available in the guidance center. Students can take these tests as often as they wish. Be sure to code the universities you wish your scores to be sent to on the application. If you need an OFFICIAL score sent to a campus, and you have not already done so, ACT Additional Score Report forms are available in the guidance center.

___ Students are encouraged to have a Resume created of the activities they have been involved in throughout their high school career. This information is very helpful to have completed prior to filling out applications for scholarships.
