Dear Parent,

As of December 14th the Department of Health Services announced that they were notifying public health agencies and private health care providers that they may begin vaccinating members of the general public.

The Public Health Unit will continue to offer the 2009 H1N1 vaccine at their regularly scheduled immunization clinics at 143 East Center Street in Juneau.

The days and times of those clinics are:

The 1st and 3rd Thursdays of each month from 3:00 pm to 6:00 pm

The 2nd Thursday of each month from 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm

The 4th Friday of the each month from 9:00 am to 11:00

H1N1 vaccine will also be offered Monday - Friday from 8:30 am to 4:00 pm on a walk in basis at the public health clinic location. The clinic location is 143 East Center Street - 2nd Floor, Juneau WI 53039.

The Public Health Unit has also scheduled two clinics, one in Beaver Dam and one in Lomira. The dates, times and locations for these clinics are:

Beaver Dam - January 19th - First Lutheran Church, 311 West Mackie Street, Beaver Dam from 3 - 6 p.m.

Lomira - January 13th - Lomira Schools, 1030 4th Street, Lomira from 3 - 5 p.m.

There is no cost for the H1N1 vaccine.

For immunization clinics including H1N1 clinics children under 18 years of age must have a parent or legal guardian present and a record of all past immunizations, including the date of their 1st H1N1 if the child is under the age of 10 years old.
