## PROM IS COMING SOON!



With Prom coming soon on May 2, 2009, sign-up for guests (non-Mayville students) will be accepted until Wednesday, April 29th. When you come into the office to sign up your guest, be sure to pick up a Guest Pass Application Form that needs to be completed, signed by your parent/guardian, and also signed by an official of the school your guest attends. The completed form then needs to be returned to Mrs. Le Bouton, Dean of Students. Please plan ahead.

1. Only MHS students are admitted to a dance without a Guest Pass.
2. All MHS students must show their valid MHS ID card to enter a dance.
3. One guest per student is allowed per dance.
4. All ticket sales are completed in advance.
5. Guest passes must be applied for in advance.
6. Guests must be high school age or under the age of 21 years old.
7. All Guest Pass Application Forms **must be** turned in or faxed in to Mrs. Le Bouton, Dean of Students, to gain approval of attending the Prom.
8. All dances must end no later than 12:00 AM (midnight).
9. Once students choose to leave a dance, they may not re-enter.
10. Breathalyzer tests or other checks for suspected substance abuse will take place when a student is suspected of being "under the influence." The Police will be called.

### Attire

*Our students have done a good job conforming to attire expectations. Listed below are the dance attire expectations.*

School rules apply to attire worn to the dance. This means that outerwear items (hats, jackets, etc.) are not to be worn inside. Inappropriate T-shirts and clothing may not be worn. Restrictions in the manner of dress may be imposed. Dresses are required to have proper coverage. Spaghetti straps and exposed shoulders will be allowed but *discouraged*. "Exposed backsides" should be kept to a minimum and be modest. Students will not be allowed to participate if their apparel is deemed inappropriate. See Mrs. Le Bouton, Dean of Students, for clarification or feedback on appropriate attire.

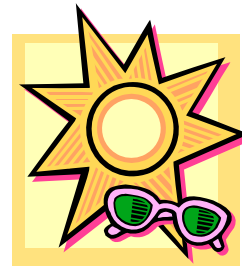
