ATTENTION ALL ATHLETES: See pages 3 & 4 for information regarding Fall Sports.

FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL: The first day of school for the 2010-11 school year will be on Wednesday, September 1st. Students will have school on Wednesday and Thursday, Sept. 1st and 2nd. No school will be held on Friday, Sept. 3rd or Monday, Sept. 6th (Labor Day).

PICTURE DAY is on Wednesday, September 8, 2010. **(Please Note: The school dress code will be enforced, no spaghetti straps, etc. will be allowed. Please refer to Student Handbook for complete dress code. Students unable to modify attire will not have pictures taken but will wait until Retake Day.)**

The date for **PICTURE RE-TAKE DAY** is still to be determined.

HIGH SCHOOL OPEN HOUSE will be held on Tuesday, August 24th from 3:30 – 6:30 p.m. Please mark this date on your calendar. This will be a great opportunity to meet your child's teachers, learn about Skyward Family Access, purchase and pick up locks, PE uniforms, parking passes, and season activity passes. Students may set up their lockers and bring any school materials to store in their lockers.

Registration packets were mailed to Mayville School District families on Thursday, July 22nd. The due date for returning registration materials is on Friday, August 6th. In addition to completing the registration materials that were mailed, high school families should access the Mayville Schools website (www.mayvilleschools.com) to print out additional forms to be completed. LUNCH DEPOSITS – Please keep in mind that if you wish to add money to your child's lunch account when you submit your registration materials, you may do so, however, **a separate check is needed for the lunch deposit.**

Schedule Information:

Schedules have been posted on the Mayville School District website at mayvilleschools.com, then Parent Access. Please be aware that some of the hours on the schedule may be changed due to the need to balance sections as the summer progresses.

Seniors will be able to modify their schedules to fit in their work experience hours when school begins in the Fall.

Schedule change requests can be made when school begins. Changes will happen during the first four days of school in the guidance office, in addition, Mrs. Paszek will have office hours.

School Locks – It is highly recommended that students purchase locks for their regular lockers, as well as their physical education lockers. Master locks must be purchased at the high school. Cost of the locks is \$3.00 for used

locks (if available) and \$5.25 for new locks. **Keep in mind that the school will not be responsible for items missing from lockers if the lockers are not locked.**

Lockers – All students will be assigned new lockers for the 2010-11 school year. Students in each grade level will be assigned lockers in particular hallways, grouping each class in the same general area. Freshman lockers will be in the 100 wing downstairs, and Sophomores, Juniors, and Seniors will be assigned to lockers in the 200 wing. Seniors are assigned to lockers in the area of the high school office, Juniors near the library, and Sophomores further down the hallway closer to the Social Studies and English classrooms. **Students may access Parent Access, then Student Information to find their locker numbers, or students may come to the high school office for their new locker numbers.**

ATTENTION TO ALL FALL ATHLETES AND ALL CARDINAL SINGERS:

Students are reminded that three things are needed before you will be allowed to participate in athletic practices and/or events or Cardinal Singers (Show Choir). The items needed for **SPORTS** are:

1. A green sports physical card or tan alternate year card must be turned in to Mary Krapfl in the office.
2. The Co-Curricular Code Agreement needs to be completed and **signed** by both the student and his/her parent.
3. The \$30.00 per sport fee must be paid.

The items needed for **CARDINAL SINGERS ARE:**

1. The Co-Curricular Code Agreement needs to be completed and signed by both the student and his/her parent.
2. The \$30.00 Cardinal Singers fee must be paid.

MEDICATION – Due to changes in Wisconsin state law, we will no longer be able to keep stock medication, such as acetaminophen, in the office to dispense to students. All families wishing to have students take medication at school **MUST** do the following:

- Go to the Mayville School District website (mayvilleschools.com) and print out a Medical Consent Form, complete and sign the form. Indicate the medication you wish to have your child to take on the form.
- Any and all medications (including aspirin) for your child **must be brought to the high school office** in the original container with the student's name marked on the container.
- Students need to come to the office and the medication will be dispensed, as needed, by one of the high school office staff members.

GRADUATION CREDITS: IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF EACH STUDENT TO BE CERTAIN THAT HE/SHE WILL HAVE THE CORRECT AMOUNT OF CREDITS IN ORDER TO GRADUATE. A total of 23 credits are required for graduation from Mayville High School. Students need to obtain graduation credits as follows:

English	4 credits
Mathematics	2 credits
Science	2 credits
Social Sciences	3 credits
Physical Education	1 ½ credits
Electives	<u>10 ½ credits</u>
Total	23 credits

High school staff members will be available for purchasing locks, parking permits, physical education uniforms, and season passes: Beginning August 10th, additional staff members will be available in the high school office for families to purchase locks, parking permits, physical education uniforms, and season passes. The hours parents and/or students may purchase these items are as follows:
