BOARD LEGAL STATUS

The Board of Education derives its authority to govern the local schools directly from the Wisconsin Constitution and the state statutes. Recognizing this source of authority and responsibility, the Board shall serve as the policy-making body for the schools of the District and shall serve within the framework provided by law, the will of the local citizenry and the ethics of the professional personnel employed by the Board.

The wisdom and far-sightedness of members of the Board and the effectiveness and efficiency with which the Board, as a governing body, discharges its duties and obligations determines, to a large degree, the educational level of the citizens of the School District of Mayville.

Number of Board Members

The Board shall consist of seven members.

Terms of Office

Board members shall serve for a term of three years and/or until their successors are elected and qualified.
