FILLING BOARD VACANCIES

In the event a vacancy occurs on the Board of Education due to the death, resignation, removal from office of the incumbent or other just cause as outlined by state law, the vacancy shall be filled by appointment of the remaining members of the Board.

Public notice of the vacancy shall be given by the Board Clerk in accordance with established procedures. Any qualified elector of the District may contact the Board to express an interest in filling the vacancy.

Candidates for a vacancy on the Board shall be considered at an open meeting, unless there are exceptional reasons to consider the candidates in closed session. The Board may consider candidates in a closed session only if the discussion involves financial, medical, social or personal histories or disciplinary data which, if discussed in public, would be likely to have a substantial adverse effect upon the reputation of the candidates. A majority vote shall be required for all appointments to the Board.

The candidate appointed to the vacancy shall, pending acceptance and filing the oath of office, be seated on the Board.
