BOARD POLICY DEVELOPMENT/ADOPTION

The Board of Education shall adopt clearly defined written policies based on a thorough understanding of the educational process. In formulating such policies, the Board shall consult individuals and groups affected by the policies to the extent possible.

The adoption of new or revised policies is the sole responsibility of the Board. Policies introduced and recommended to the Board at one meeting shall not be adopted until a subsequent meeting in order to permit further study and an opportunity for interested parties to react. Temporary policy approval may, however, be granted by the Board to meet emergency conditions or address special events which will take place before formal action can be taken.

After a policy is adopted by the Board, two copies of it shall be signed by all current members of the Board for official record keeping.

Because changing conditions bring changing needs, the Board shall periodically review its policies. The Board shall rely on the administration for providing evidence of the effect of the policies on school operations.
