BOARD MEMBER ORIENTATION

The magnitude of school board membership calls for knowledge of and orientation to many areas of information and understanding. Under the guidance of experienced Board of Education members and the District Administrator, orientation will be provided to new Board members through activities such as the following:

1. Workshops for new board members conducted by state and area school board associations.
2. Discussions and visits with the District Administrator and other members of the school staff.
3. Provision of printed material, administrative policies and procedures.

New Board members should make a special effort to learn about their new job.

Orientation shall be considered as an ongoing process for all Board members in the School District of Mayville and may include such activities as those indicated above and also the following: attendance at school board and administrative conferences and conventions on a local, area, state and national basis; exchange of ideas through joint meetings with neighboring school boards; and, access to information maintained in a professional library for school board members.
