POLICY IMPLEMENTATION

While the Board of Education is the policy-making body for the District, the administration is responsible for implementation of Board policies. Continuous disregard for Board policy may be interpreted as willful neglect of duty and may constitute grounds for dismissal.

The Board delegates to the District Administrator the function of specifying required actions and designing detailed arrangements under which the schools shall be operated. These detailed arrangements shall constitute the administrative rules governing the schools. The administrative rules shall, in every respect, be consistent with Board policies, laws and regulations.

Proposals for administrative rules may be submitted by Board members, administrators and staff.

The Board itself shall formulate and adopt administrative rules only when specific laws, strong community attitudes or probable staff reaction requires the Board to do so.
