SCHOOL PERFORMANCE REPORT

The Board of Education of the School District of Mayville, recognizing its responsibility to share information about the performance of its schools and students, shall annually adopt and publish a report to the residents of the School District of Mayville. The report shall be written in plain language and shall include the following:

- (1) The results of the third-grade reading tests and other state-required achievement tests taken in the District.
- (2) Other indicators of academic achievement and school and school district performance, including: dropout, attendance, grade retention and graduation rates; numbers of suspensions and expulsions; percentage of students participating in extracurricular and community activities and advanced placement courses; percentage of graduates enrolled in post-secondary educational programs; and, percentage of graduates entering the workforce.
- (3) Staffing and financial data information as required by state law.

The school performance report shall be distributed annually to the parent/guardian of each student enrolled in the District.
