CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM DEVELOPMENT

The curriculum and instructional program in the Mayville School District shall be developed to support the District’s mission and to meet legal requirements. District shared decision-making teams comprised of staff and administrative members shall be used in the curriculum and instructional program development process.

The Board of Education shall approve the curriculum and instructional standards for the District. In addition, Board approval shall be required for all instructional programs and staffing, new course offerings and substantial changes to existing courses. Approval shall be granted before such programs or courses are implemented in the schools.

All curriculum and instructional program proposals shall be submitted and approved in accordance with established District procedures. The Board and administration reserves the right to make program modifications as necessary due to student achievement needs, enrollment, staffing, facility, fiscal and related reasons.
