CURRICULUM GUIDES

Curriculum guides shall be developed by the professional staff in harmony with state law requirements and district goals and objectives, and in accordance with established procedures. The intent of the curriculum guides is to:

- keep the school system informed as to what should be taught in a given subject area;
- help teachers new to the system know what is expected to be taught in the grade or subject area in which they serve; and
- serve as a reference for teachers in other departments and grades to see what educational experiences their students may have had.

Curriculum guides shall include, but not be limited to the following areas: philosophy, behavioral objectives, scope and sequence, basic texts and equipment needs.

No teacher is expected to teach everything that is included in the curriculum guide, nor are teachers expected to use all of the suggested methods and materials. The teacher is expected to follow the content approximately, making changes as they may be needed.
