### ART EDUCATION

The Mayville Board of Education directs that the art education curriculum is comprised of the regular rotation of its curriculum. To that end, the curriculum coordinator shall appoint an appropriate committee to review and evaluate the K-12 art education program. The curriculum shall include instructional experiences in sensory awareness, cultural heritage, aesthetic discrimination and studio opportunities in a wide variety of two and three dimensional art processes.

The art committee will review the art curriculum on a regular basis and present any recommendations for changes to the overall school art program or curricular offerings to the District Administrator. The art program and curricular offerings should reflect the changes and needs of society.

All students in grades 1-6 will be provided art instruction by a Department of Public Instruction certified art teacher. For students in grades 7-12, art instruction shall be available as an elective course and shall be taught by a DPI certified art teacher. Secondary school art programs shall seek to include a basic studio survey course and at least two courses in studio areas such as ceramics, sculpture, painting, printmaking, jewelry, drawing, and fibers. Kindergarten art classes shall be taught by the kindergarten teacher.

Equipment and supplies necessary for providing appropriate art education will be requisitioned and purchased by the District to insure that the District adequately meets the needs of the art education program.

Inservice activities devoted to art education and its relationship to other curricular areas will be scheduled by the district's staff development coordinator whenever it is deemed appropriate.
