PROGRAMS FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES (Special education)

The district affirms its responsibility to make appropriate special education programs and related services available to students with disabilities in accordance with federal and state laws. Consistent with the commitment made to students with disabilities by state and federal laws, all children, ages 3-21, have the right to a free and appropriate public education regardless of the type or severity of disability. To carry out its responsibility, the district believes that students with disabilities should receive special education services in the local school district when appropriate. Placement is based upon the student's Individual Education Plan (IEP) and includes regular education classes when appropriate.

The district shall ensure all supportive and related services needed to assist an individual student to benefit from special education will be provided. Students with disabilities enrolled in private or parochial schools in the district may participate in district special education programs to the extent noted in the district's special education plan in accordance with state and federal laws.

All district special education programs and the placement of students with disabilities shall be under the direction and supervision of the Director of Special Education and shall be in accordance with state and federal laws. The processes used to make decisions concerning special education services are outlined in the Special Education Procedures handbook. The handbook shall be subject to update and revision as necessary.

Due process safeguards for parental/student rights and appeal are within the parameters of state and federal laws and shall be adhered to by the district. The district shall complete all special education report forms and district plans as required by the Department of Public Instruction.
