CLASS SIZE

The Board of Education of the School District of Mayville is aware that class size has bearing upon effective teaching. The Board, therefore, directs the District Administrator to work with principals in establishing a reasonable and equitable class enrollment for each teacher.

The Board understands that achieving this goal is dependent upon the financial ability of the District. In determining the size of various classes, the administration will consider the following factors:

1. the type of load that will help the teacher be most effective with the students in the class;
2. the experience of the teacher and familiarity with Mayville programs and policies; and
3. the degree of need for individualization of instruction.
