FULL-TIME STUDENTS

Students shall be considered full time for District membership count purposes as follows:

- a. High school students, including special education students, enrolled/registered in seven periods each school day will be considered full-time students.
- b. Seventh and eighth grade students, including special education students, enrolled/registered in seven periods each school day will be considered full-time students.
- c. Elementary school students (K-6), including special education students, who attend school during the regular school hours of their assigned building will be considered full-time students.
- d. Early childhood program students (students with disabilities who are not five years old) who participate in the program prescribed by the individualized education program (IEP) team will be considered full-time students. Their attendance will conform to the time schedule of the building of assignment.
- e. Resident students attending another public school district under the full-time public school open enrollment program will be considered full-time students.
- f. Special Provisions
 - (1) Homebound students will be considered full time if they are programmed by the IEP team or principal and then provided homebound instruction according to the program developed by the principal or IEP team.
 - (2) Work-study students – Twelfth grade students, registered in the cooperative/work program will be considered full time if they are enrolled in five periods each school day, in addition to two periods in cooperative work experience each school day, or six periods each school day in addition to one period of cooperative work experience each school day.
 - (3) A student enrolled in an alternative education program or participating in other program or curriculum modifications approved by school officials consistent with state law and Board policy will be considered full-time students.
