

**SCHOOL DISTRICT OF MAYVILLE**

ENTRANCE AGE

A child must be five years old on or before September 1 in the year he/she proposes to enter school to be admitted to kindergarten or six years old on or before September 1 to be admitted to first grade. The District may admit children to kindergarten or first grade at an age below the legal age in accordance with established District guidelines.

Admission of students to other grades shall involve a consideration of chronological age, placement in previous school of attendance and the readiness of the student to do the work required.
