### **ADMISSION OF FOREIGN EXCHANGE STUDENTS**

The Board of Education recognizes the value of allowing foreign exchange program students to attend school in the District. The presence of foreign exchange program students can be an important addition to the instructional program for the individual participants, the student bodies and the residents of the Mayville community.

Students who participate in foreign exchange programs may attend Mayville High School provided they are assigned to families who are legal residents of the District, the sponsoring organization is approved by the Board and requirements outlined in District procedures are met. No more than three (3) foreign exchange program students may be enrolled in Mayville High School tuition free in one school year.

Applications for admission of foreign exchange program students shall be approved by the High School Principal prior to enrollment of any foreign exchange program student in the District. It is the organization's responsibility to secure school placement prior to determining final host family placement. The Board shall be informed of any foreign exchange program student(s) approved for school admission.

Because of its belief in the foreign exchange student program and its positive impact on the District, the Board authorizes the District to furnish the following items at District expense to foreign exchange program students: student passes to all home school activities, graduation announcements (limited to five), graduation cap and gown and a copy of the school yearbook.
