RELEASE TIME FOR STUDENTS

Students shall be in school from the time the school day begins until the end of the designated school day, except as otherwise specifically provided by Board policy. This includes noon hour.

In exceptional instances, the building principal may permit a student to leave the building or grounds during the noon hour. The principal shall review individual requests on a daily basis for the student who desires to leave school during the noon hour. High school students may be allowed, at the discretion of the High School Principal, to use a car during the school day under special circumstances.
