STUDENT CONDUCT ON SCHOOL BUSES

The school bus is considered to be an extension of the classroom. Therefore, the Board of Education shall require students to conduct themselves while on the bus in a manner consistent with established standards for classroom behavior. A set of bus rider rules shall be developed each fall by the Director of Operations and shall be distributed to the parents/guardians of all students who ride school buses.

Students who violate bus rider rules may be subject to disciplinary action. All cases of discipline on school buses shall be reported by the bus driver, in writing, to the Director of Operations, who will provide a copy of the report to the appropriate building principal. Building principals and the Director of Operations are authorized to suspend the bus riding privileges of a student. Before a student is suspended from riding the bus, a conference shall be held with the student(s), the Director of Operations and the principal. Parents/guardians shall be notified prior to the implementation of any suspension from riding the bus. It is the principal's responsibility to notify the parent/guardian of the bus misconduct incident and of any disciplinary action taken. Parents/guardians may contact the Director of Operations if they are not satisfied with the action taken.
