

STUDENT CONDUCT

Students in the School District of Mayville shall be expected to act in such fashion that their behavior will reflect favorably on the individual student and on the school, show consideration for fellow students, and create a harmonious school atmosphere. To accomplish this, each student must recognize individual responsibilities and obligations, and discharge them in accordance with school regulations.

Students are expected to abide by the code of school and classroom conduct adopted by the Board, district policies and school rules. The code of school and classroom conduct and other rules of student behavior shall be included in the student handbooks published annually in the district.

All employees shall share responsibility for supervising the behavior of students and for seeing that they meet the standards of conduct established by the Board and administration. In enforcing rules for student conduct, staff members shall place particular emphasis upon educating students in the ability to control themselves.

The School District of Mayville shall not discriminate in standards and rules of behavior, including student harassment, on the basis of sex, race, color, national origin, religion, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
