PROFESSIONAL STAFF DEVELOPMENT OPPORTUNITIES

The District Administrator is responsible for developing a staff development program for all professional personnel, in cooperation with a committee selected by the District Administrator and President of the Mayville Education Association.

The program shall be designed by the committee to provide annual inservice activities as well as professional development for the individual professional staff member. Inservice activities should be of a nature that will examine all school programs in an attempt to identify needs, assign priorities and provide solutions. In order to insure maximum effectiveness and utilization, the program must be relevant to individual staff members as well as District needs. The program shall be operated under the mission, goals and objectives of the District. The ultimate goal is to improve the education of children.
