### COURTESY PASS GUIDELINES

The following courtesy passes shall be honored by the School District of Mayville:

#### A. **Adults**

1. East Central Conference and Flyway Conference Courtesy Passes  
The Conference Passes are issued by the conferences involved and are to be honored for regular season athletic events only. WIAA tournaments are not part of the Conference Pass.
2. Senior Citizen Pass  
The Senior Citizen Courtesy Pass will be offered to any citizen of the School District of Mayville who is 62 years of age or older. These passes will be good for home athletic contests (regular season only) and for all choral and instrumental concerts. These passes are not valid at plays and musical performances.
3. Retired District Employees  
A courtesy pass shall be given to all retired District employees and their spouses. This pass shall be good for all home athletic contests, the fall, winter and spring band and choral concerts, and all school dances.
4. Board of Education Members  
Board members and their spouses, when accompanied by the Board member, shall receive a courtesy pass to all home school activities. If a meal is involved with the activity, the Board member shall be expected to pay for his/her and his/her spouse's meal. The Board member may then submit the cost of his/her meal for reimbursement from the District.
5. School Staff  
All home school staff and their spouses shall be eligible for a courtesy pass. These passes will be good for home athletic contests (regular season only) and for all choral and instrumental concerts. These passes are not valid at plays and musical performances.
6. Coaches  
In some cases, coaches of the District may not be employees of the District. In these cases, those coaches and their spouses shall be given courtesy passes to all home school athletic events.

#### B. **Students**

1. Band  
Only band members who are playing in the Pep Band at the athletic event/activity that evening shall receive admission.

2. Cheerleaders  
High school cheerleaders in uniform will receive free admission to the athletic event at which they are cheerleading.
3. Statisticians  
Students who are currently keeping statistics for the particular team competing that evening shall receive free admission.
4. Video Taping  
Students who are video taping for that evening's activity shall receive free admission.
5. High School Athletes  
High school students who are out for the sport will receive free admission to the varsity home level events of that particular sport.
6. Foreign Exchange Students  
Foreign exchange students shall receive courtesy passes for all home activities.

**C. Others**

1. Concession Workers  
Students and/or adults who are working in the concession stand shall receive free admission for that evening's event only.
2. Workers  
Those people that are actively engaged in score keeping, chaperoning, ticket selling or in any other way helping with the operation of the event that evening shall receive free admission.
3. Clergy  
Any clergy and spouse who serves in a church located in the School District of Mayville will receive a courtesy pass good for all home athletic contests (regular season only), and for all choral and instrumental concerts. These passes are not valid at plays and musical performances.
4. Doctor  
The doctor on duty for an athletic contest shall receive free admission for that evening's contest.
5. Press  
Any member of the press actively working for a home activity/event shall receive free admission.
6. Trainer  
Anyone serving in the capacity of trainer for either competing athletic team shall receive free admission to the event for that evening.

7. Emergency Medical Technicians (EMTs)  
Any EMT appearing at the activity with his/her EMT jacket and prepared to lend assistance, if needed, shall receive free admission.
  
8. Children  
All children ages of three and under shall be admitted at no charge to all home school activities.
  
9. Wisconsin Interscholastic Athletics Association (WIAA)-Issued Courtesy Passes  
The WIAA issues courtesy passes to a select number of coaches and administration from the participating schools for WIAA tournaments. These passes will be honored for tournament games only.
  
10. Season passes may be purchased at the high school office or by contacting the athletic director.
