SCHOOL STORE SALES

A school store shall be operated at the high school under the direction of the High School Principal and in accordance with established procedures. The High School Principal shall have the ultimate responsibility for the operation of the school store and his/her discretion shall be used in its operation.

The school store operation shall be directly related to the service and convenience of the students and to the instructional/learning objectives of the distributive education curriculum. The purpose of the school store shall be to provide learning experiences for students enrolled in the distributive education program in the following areas: purchasing, selling and sales, cash register operation, promotional activities, display and presentation of merchandise, inventory and audit. The school store is to be considered a laboratory for the distributive education program and a part of the instructional program of the distributive education curriculum and not an extracurricular activity.

The school store shall be operated in such a way that there will be no interference with the academic programs of the students or the assigned duties of teachers. Any proceeds from school store sales are to be used to pay store operating expenses and to benefit the distributive education program. The operation of the school store (revenues and expenses) shall be operated and accounted for through an activity fund maintained at the district level
