ADMINISTRATIVE DIRECTIVE 672

GIFTS/GRATUITIES TO SCHOOL PERSONNEL

No school employee shall accept a personal gift (such as meals, hospitality rooms, athletic equipment, clothing, food, etc.) from any company, company representative or individual that could directly or indirectly be construed to influence the purchase of materials or equipment, or business transactions with the District.

Persons involving themselves in the above manner could subject themselves to immediate dismissal from employment with the District, consistent with provisions of any applicable collective bargaining agreement or employment contract.

Gifts that are given through the school which carry the advertiser's name or product promotion would be exempt from the above ruling. This would be classified as advertising and would not be considered a gift. This type of promotional would be considered to be given to the school as a whole rather than to an individual.
