**BOMB THREATS**

The Board of Education recognizes the problem of a threat of a bomb being placed in the school buildings, therefore, the District Administrator is instructed to develop a plan to insure the safety of students, faculty and other school personnel in the event of a bomb threat.

The plan of operation shall facilitate the notification of the police, the evacuation of the building and other emergency procedures deemed necessary by the District Administrator.

Any school time missed because of the interruption may be made up as directed by the school district administrator.
