### FOOD SERVICES MANAGEMENT

The School District of Mayville operates a lunchroom in each school that is under the supervision of the Director of Food Service and Business Office.

District food services shall include hot lunches provided through participation in the National School Lunch Program. As required for participation in the National School Lunch Program, the Board of Education agrees to make a "Type A" lunch available for students and to provide free and reduced price lunches for students who cannot afford to pay the price of the "Type A" lunch. The school lunch program shall be operated in accordance with state and federal laws and regulations.

Students may participate in the school lunch program or may bring their own lunches from home or purchase items from the ala carte menu at school.

The Board shall approve school lunch prices. Staff members who wish to participate in the electronically automated school lunch program shall purchase meals in accordance with procedures established by the Director of Food Service. Parents and visitors to the Mayville Public Schools who are guests of the Board or administration shall be considered guests. Items purchased will be scanned and charged to the proper account.

The School District of Mayville shall not discriminate in school-sponsored food service programs on the basis of sex, age, race, religion, color, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
