Today's new technologies have made learning and information gathering more readily available than ever before and have made it easier to reproduce or copy the material. The District believes a balance must be achieved to meet the needs of society to have access to information and for proper remuneration to its creators. Therefore, it is the intention of the Board of Education that all copyright laws be observed in the District.

Copyrighted materials may be duplicated only with the prior written permission of the copyright holder, or when the duplication constitutes a "fair use" of the materials as defined by law. No school equipment or materials shall be used by school employees, students or others for illegal copying or usage. Those violating the copyright laws shall be liable for their own actions

Notices of copyright restrictions shall be placed on and/or near those devices that could be used for copying materials or information (e.g., computers, photocopiers, video cassette recorders).
