

**SCHOOL DISTRICT OF MAYVILLE**

**INSURANCE PROGRAM**

The Board of Education shall maintain an adequate insurance program to protect the property of the District from fire, vandalism and theft; to protect Board members, employees and appointed officers against general liability resulting from the discharge of their duties; to offer protection against injury for employees while acting in behalf of the District; and, to protect the District against bus transportation liability. The Board shall also provide for other insurance coverage in accordance with state laws, Board policies and provisions of the current employee agreements.

The District will make every effort to obtain insurance at the most economical cost, consistent with required service, by obtaining quotations or by negotiation. The responsibility for administering the total insurance program shall be delegated to the (e.g., District Administrator).
