Reading & Writing: (2 consecutive hours) Grade 4

READ, CREATE, AND PERFORM This class is for the 4th graders who want to create stories and share them with other students. It's a great way to bring your own stories to life. You will become the characters and will create props to help you act out the stories.

Reading & Writing: (runs 2 consecutive hours) Grade: 5

Be ready to explore faraway places and learn new words to increase your vocabulary. Discuss your favorite books. Write about places you've been and those places you wish to explore. Helpful hints will make writing fun. Enjoy and write about nature.

Grade 4 Math: Grade 4

MATH MANIA Jump into this class with both feet! Get the facts down and the problems solved. This class is perfect to brush up on numbers and eat food right along with it.

Grade 5 Math: Grade 5

Master those facts for 6th grade. Make up your own problems to trick the class. You'll be a math whiz by summer's end!

Around the World with Food and Fun: Grade 4 & 5

Celebrate culture by exploring heritage at Mayville Middle School and throughout the world. We will taste food from other countries and cultures, create crafts like a Chinese lantern, a Spanish piñata, and a German pinwheel.

Arts & Crafts Grade: Grade 4 & 5

Non traditional class projects like piñatas, bead weaving, clay, plaster carving, and bookmaking.

Beginning Band Lessons: Grade 4

The lessons are intended for incoming 5th grade students who have not played an instrument before. If you are currently enrolled in 5-8th grade band, please read about the "private/small group lessons listed in this brochure.

Baseball Skills: Grade 4 & 5

This class is designed to teach the basic skills associated with the game of baseball while having fun at the same time.

Baseball Fever: Grade 4 & 5

We will look at various aspects of baseball. Students will learn about the history of baseball including famous players. We will do literature circles as well. Students will use their math skills as well as their artistic ability in this class.

Boys and Girls Basketball: Grade 4

This course will emphasize offensive skills of shooting, ball-handling and passing. Skills taught will have a carry-over impact for future years. All students/players will have the same number of reps and teaching.

Boys 3x3 Basketball Skills: Grade 5

This course will emphasize offensive skills of shooting, ball-handling and passing.
3 x 3 games will be played emphasizing skills taught.

Chess: Grade 4 & 5

This will be an introductory course teaching games skills and game strategies while learning various chess styles. Students will play a tournament series during this course.

Fishing 101 (Class limit of 15 Students): Grade 4 & 5

Students will learn about the fish of Wisconsin and the basics of how to catch them. Students will learn basic knot tying, multiple ways to cast, how to bait a hook, and most importantly safety. They will also learn to be a good sportsman (or woman) and respect the environment around them.

Girls 3x3 Basketball Skills: Grade 5

This course will emphasize offensive skills of shooting, ball-handling and passing.
3 x 3 games will be played emphasizing skills taught.

Harry Potter: Grade 4 & 5

Each week, we will explore a different book of the Harry Potter series through reading and projects. On the final week, we will plan and implement a game of Quidditch.

Kids in the Kitchen: Grade 4 & 5

You will learn cooking terms, and how to figure out measurements. Come discover the world of cook books. Become a master chef as you will test these new recipes.

Kids Pics: Grade 4

This graphics program is designed to allow students to design their own stamps, animations, and other graphic designs.

Knitting-Beginning: Grade 4 & 5

This class is designed to teach the basic skills of knitting

Knitting-Advanced: Gr. 4 & 5

This class is for students who have already mastered the basic skill of knitting.

Making a Newspaper: Grade 4 & 5

Learn the ins and the outs of putting together printed media by visiting a local newspaper, talking to a reporter, and discovering what is all in a newspaper. We will then publish a personal paper to be taken home.

Model Building: Grade 4 & 5

You will learn the steps needed to successfully put a model together, whether it's a car, plane, ship, spaceship....Your finished project should be just like the real one. **Only requirement is to bring you own model(s) on the first day of class.**

Phy. Ed. Fun: Grade 4 & 5

This highly active class will keep you moving with a variety of Phy. Ed. Games and activities.

Power Point: Grade 5

Student will learn the basic fundamentals of Microsoft Power Point and learn the basics of making presentations using the Power Point software. This program is used for many school assignments and this course provides an opportunity to learn and use this very exciting program.

Private/Small Group Band Lessons 12:00 p.m. -2:00 p.m.

These lessons are intended for **students currently in grades 5-12**. Students will receive one 20-minute lesson per week during the weeks that summer school is in session. Lessons are scheduled in the afternoon. Summer lessons are encouraged because they will help students to progress faster on their instrument. Read any Good Books Lately?: Grade 4 & 5

Cuddle up with a good book and simply enjoy the adventure the words take you on as you read the books you have always wanted to read but didn't have enough time too. Class begins with a read aloud mini-lesson, followed by an uninterrupted reading time (Bring your favorite stuffed animal or pillow to keep you company), and concludes with a group sharing of what you read.

Science Secrets: Grade 4 & 5

Explore chemistry, geology and botany as you experiment with ordinary stuff found at home. Learn the scientific method of planning and researching before the experiment, recording data, and the forming of a conclusion based on your observation of the experiment.

Sewing: Grade 4 & 5

You will do cross stitch and/or other sewing activities that your imagination can create.

Spanish : Grade 4 & 5

Bienvenidos a la clase de espanol – learn more vocabulary in Spanish! We will review alphabet, colors, numbers and body parts. We will expand our knowledge to learn animals, classroom objects, clothing and family members with many interactive games and songs! We will break a piñata at the end of the course

Who Says Math Can't be Fun: Grade 4

Use your current math skills and apply those computation and thinking skills to playing math board games, dice games, card games, and Internet math related games/activities. Enjoy using your time in this class to polish and practice your math skills while you engage in math game activities with your friends.

Woods: Grade 5

This class is designed to get kids familiar with basic hand and power tools. We will learn how to safely use the band saw, scroll saw, table saw and radial arm saw in the completion of basic woods projects. This is a great starter class for kids who want to learn more about woodworking.

Wrestling: Grade 4 & 5

This course is intended to be a fun introduction to the sport of wrestling. Students will learn basic wrestling terms and techniques.
