Baseball Skills: Grade 6-8

This course will emphasize the skills needed to play baseball, including batting, fielding, pitching and base running.

Boys 3x3 Basketball Skills: Grade 6, 7 & 8

This course will emphasize offensive skills of shooting, ball-handling and passing. 3 x 3 games will be played emphasizing skills taught.

Chess: Grade 6 - 8

This will be an introductory course teaching game skills and game strategies while learning various chess styles. Students will play a tournament series during this course.

Fishing 101: Grade 6

In this class students will learn about the fish of Wisconsin and the basics of how to catch them. Students will learn basic knot tying, multiple ways to cast, how to bait a hook, and most importantly safety. They will also learn ways to be a good sportsman (or woman) and respect the environment around them.

Girls 3x3 Basketball Skills: Grade 6, 7 & 8

This course will emphasize offensive skills of shooting, ball-handling and passing. 3 x 3 games will be played emphasizing skills taught.

Jr. Show Choir: Grade 6 & 7 (Period 3 & 4)

Any students entering grades 7 and 8 are invited to learn about show choir, either performing as a singer or band member. 6th graders will be accepted by audition. What a great time to get started in a long standing Mayville tradition, students who participate in summer show choir are then invited to belong to the junior high competitive show choir which starts in the fall.

Kids in the Kitchen: Grade 6- 8

You will learn cooking terms, and how to figure out measurements. Come discover the world of cook books. Become a master chef as you will test these new recipes.

Knitting-Beginning: Grade 6-8

This class is designed to teach the basic skills of knitting

Knitting-Advanced: Grade 6-8

This class is for students who have already mastered the basic skill of knitting.

Math: Grade 6

Jumpstart to Jr. High. This course is designed to build confidence and reinforce math skills. The focus will be on whole numbers, fractions, decimals, percentages, geometry, and pre-algebra. This course is for any student entering Jr. High needing to catch up, keep up, or get ahead!

Math: Grade 7 & 8

This course is designed to build confidence and reinforce math skills. The focus will be on whole numbers, fractions, decimals, percentages, geometry, and pre-algebra. Jr. High students needing to catch up, keep up, or get ahead!

Model Building: Grade 6

You will learn the steps needed to successfully put a model together, whether it's a car, plane, ship, spaceship....Your finished project should be just like the real one. **Only requirement is to bring you own model(s) on the first day of class.**

Mural Painting (Student may take ONLY 1 hour of this class): Grades: 6-8

This class will give you the opportunity to paint BIG on the walls!! You'll be working together as a class to help beautify MMS. This class will be a lot of fun and just think how proud you'll be when you walk by your mural next year.

Power Point: Grade 6

Students will learn the basic fundamentals of Microsoft Power Point and the basics of making presentations using the Powerpoint software. This program is used for many school assignments and this course provides an opportunity to learn and use this very exciting program.

Private/Small Group Band Lessons 12:00 p.m. -2:00 p.m.

These lessons are intended for **students currently in grades 5-12**. Students will receive one 20-minute lesson per week during the weeks that summer school is in session. Lessons are scheduled in the afternoon. Summer lessons are encouraged because they will help students to progress faster on their instrument. Reading and Writing: Grade: 6- 8

This course will provide a practical review of fiction and nonfiction reading strategies using a variety of engaging texts. Six Trait Writing skills will be reinforced using various writing activities. Writing styles of many authors will be analyzed, and students will experiment with their own unique writing styles.

Science Secrets: Grade 6- 8

Explore chemistry, geology and botany as you experiment with ordinary stuff found at home. Learn the scientific method of planning and researching before the experiment, recording data, and the forming of a conclusion based on your observing the experiment.

Sewing: Grade 6- 8

You will do cross stitch and/or other sewing activities that your imagination can create.

Spanish: Grade 6

Bienvenidos a la clase de español – learn more vocabulary in Spanish! We will review alphabet, colors, numbers and body parts. We will expand our knowledge to learn animals, classroom objects, clothing and family members with many interactive games and songs! We will break a piñata at the end of the course.

Summer Strength and Conditioning for High School: Grade 8

An advanced strength and conditioning course to promote a physically fit athlete for all Mayville athletics. This course includes strength, core/balance, speed, cardio and agility training.

Summer Strength and Fitness for Middle School: Grade 6 & 7

Students will be educated in proper weight room techniques, safety and etiquette, sprint/speed mechanics, athletic movements and increasing their cardio fitness. This course includes strength, core/balance, speed, cardio and agility training.

Woods: Grade 6

This class is designed to get kids familiar with basic hand and power tools. We will learn how to safely use the band saw, scroll saw, table saw and radial arm saw in the completion of basic woods projects. This is a great starter class for kids who want to learn more about woodworking.

Woods: Grade 7& 8

This class will be very similar to the 6th grade wood class. However, we will try to introduce the power planer, jointer and router as well as the equipment listed in 6th grade woods. Projects in this woods class will be different than the 6th grade woods class. This is a great class for both the experienced and the inexperienced woodworkers.

Wrestling: Grade 6 & 7

This course is intended to be a fun introduction to the sport of wrestling. Students will learn basic wrestling terms and techniques.
