Pre-Kindergarten Students must be entering Kindergarten in the fall of 2011 (all classes will be held at the Middle School)

An introduction to Kindergarten. Each student will be introduced to a scheduled routine of learning including letters and sounds of the alphabet, number recognition & writing along with small and large motor skills and social skills. Each child must attend Periods 1-4. Students will experience large and small group sessions as well as individual help, when needed.

Grades K and 1

Stepping Stones for Academic Success: Grade K (Register for periods 1 and 2)

Ongoing development and instruction in Guided Reading, word work, writing, and math, at the Kindergarten level. This integrated class was created to review and reinforce mastery of Kindergarten academic skills in a small group setting.

Stepping Stones for Academic Success: Grade 1 (Register for periods 3 and 4)

Ongoing development and instruction in Guided Reading, word work, writing, and math, at the first grade level. This integrated class was created to review and reinforce mastery of first grade academic skills in a small group setting.

Animal Tales: Grade K & 1

Time to get wild! In this class we will look at a variety of animals to see what they do in real life and the fantastic things they can do in stories. Some of the animals covered include bears, pigs, donkeys, alligators, crocodiles, ants, frogs and toads.

Arts & Crafts = Fun: Grade 1

This class is a beginning class for crafting and painting, along with sculpting. It 's a fun class for little tykes and all the projects can go home. Sign up and let's have some messy fun!

Basketball Co-ed: Grade K, 1, 2

This course will emphasize offensive skills of shooting, ball-handling and passing. Skills taught will have a carry-over impact for future years. All students/players will have the same number of reps and teaching.

Dinosaurs: Grade K & 1

Step back in time a million or more years ago to the wonderful world of extinct plants and animals. You will participate in activities and discussion about dinosaurs.

Dr. Seuss: Grade K & 1

Let's dive in with Dr. Seuss and read some of his hilarious, exciting books. You will learn by rhyming, baking, and exchanging many books. An excellent way to meet the author.

Fun and Games: Grade K & 1

This active class is designed to help you develop your motor skills and build a positive self-image toward physical activities. Activities will be performed in a non-competitive setting. **Gym shoes required.**

Kids Pics: Grade K & 1

This graphics program is designed to allow students to design their own stamps, animations, and other graphic designs.

Kinder Art: Grade K

Make a variety of art projects designed for the young artist.

Math Munchies: Grade K & 1

Explore math readiness and beginning math skills. You will have fun sorting, patterning, counting, measuring, weighing, adding and subtracting all kinds of yummy foods.

Phy Ed Fun: Grade K & 1

Explore activities through active participation.

Sign Language: Grade K & 1

Do you want to learn to talk with your mouth full? Students will learn the manual alphabet and core vocabulary for action words, animals, colors, foods, and school language. Aspects of Deaf culture and equipment used by deaf or hard of hearing people will also be presented.

Spanish: Grade K & 1

Bienvenidos a la clase de espanol – learn beginning vocabulary in Spanish! We will learn the alphabet, colors, numbers, animals and body parts with many different activities including songs! We will break a piñata at the end of the course.

Wrestling: Grade K & 1
